

HSBC U.S. Treasury Money Market Fund

Share Class D

Objective and strategy

The Fund seeks to provide as high a level of current income as is consistent with the preservation of capital and liquidity. The Fund will invest in direct obligations of the United States Treasury which have remaining maturities of 397 days or less. The Fund will maintain a dollar weighted average portfolio maturity of 60 days or less and a dollar weighted average portfolio life of 120 days or less. Although it is not the Fund's current intention to do so, as a defensive mechanism, the Fund may temporarily invest in repurchase agreements collateralized by U.S. Treasury obligations.

Investment concerns
